Taking Your New Kitten Home

There are three simple steps in adopting your new Toskharags kitten. Following these steps will activate your health guarantee and rapidly acclimate your kitten to your home.

1. **Vet Check** Make an appointment for your kitten before you pick the kitten up. You have 72 hours from the time of picking the kitten up to have it checked by a vet. Failure to have the kitten vet checked within 72 hours will void the health guarantee in the contract.
2. **Proof of Vet Check to Toskharags** Send proof of the vet check to Toskharags within 48 hours of exam. Failure to provide proof of vet check to Toskharags within 48 hours of the vet check will void the health guarantee in the contract.
3. **Acclimate Kitten to Your Home** It is very stressful for your kitten to go to its new home and be separated from its litter mates. Follow this simple and proven approach to have a happy and well-adjusted kitten.
 - a. Put the kitten in a small room like a bathroom with food, water and a litter box. Several times a day, as often as you can, spend time in the room with the kitten. Play with the kitten, pet and stroke it, and talk to it quietly. Introduce toys and encourage active play. Keep small children, loud children and energetic children away from the kitten as they will scare the kitten. All children should be carefully supervised to make sure all play is comfortable for the kitten.
 - b. After a couple of days when the kitten is comfortable and bonded with you, open it to a larger room like a bedroom. Continue to play with and socialize the kitten.
 - c. Gradually increase the area of the home open to the kitten until it is comfortable in all of the home you want open to the kitten.
 - d. Failure to follow these instructions are likely to result in a kitten hiding under furniture afraid of you and other family members. Attempting to catch or handle the kitten may further scare or traumatize it. This stresses the kitten and make them susceptible to sickness. Remember they are young and fragile, they need lots of attention in a safe and secure environment. Failure to follow this proven approach may result in a scared and poorly adjusted kitten.
 - e. Call us anytime if you have questions/concerns.

Under no circumstances is this Kitten/Cat allowed to roam outdoors or be declawed

Breeder guarantees the Kitten/Cat to be healthy at the time of purchase and delivery. Buyer agrees to have kitten vet-checked within 72 hours of purchase and a copy of exam submitted to Toskharags within 48 hours. If it is found that there is a health question, Buyer has 48 hours after veterinary exam in which to ask for a Kitten/Cat replacement. This request must accompany a letter from the veterinarian stating why the Kitten/Cat's health is in question. There will be no cash refunds.

Kitten/Cat has a 2 year guarantee against lethal genetic or congenital defects. Kitten is guaranteed with no FIP for 16 months. If the Kitten/Cat should die or have to be destroyed within these time limits, breeder will replace the Kitten/Cat, upon being provided an autopsy report but is not obligated to replace the exact color or pattern. There will be no cash refunds. Breeder will not be responsible for any shipping costs. The autopsy report must be from a licensed veterinary pathologist stating unquestionably a genetic or congenital defect, and is at the Buyer's expense.

This kitten will have been dewormed and had 2 (two) Fel-O-Vax IV + CACICVAX vaccinations these vaccination must be given annually by buyer hereafter. Guarantee will be null and void if the kitten is given a 3rd set of vaccinations in its first year. Breeder agrees to provide a complete record of all deworming and vaccinations for this Kitten/Cat. Breeder will not be responsible for any adverse reactions to subsequent vaccines.

There are only **TWO** vaccinations needed for the life of your kitten/cat: There are only **TWO** vaccinations needed annually for the life of your kitten/cat Fel-O-Vax IV + CACICVAX (Boehringer Ingelheim) & Rabies.

Please wait to give Rabies vaccine at about 4 months of age, or later

These 2 vaccinations MUST be given at separate vet visits, at least one month apart, for the life of your cat!

If Buyer chooses to inoculate for FIP and/or FeLV, Breeder will not guarantee kitten. As your Ragdoll is an inside cat only, we feel these vaccinations are too dangerous and not necessary.

Buyer agrees to spay or neuter kitten, at around 4-5 months of age.

Buyer may pick up kitten from breeder at about 12-15 weeks of age at an equally convenient date and time to breeder and buyer.

Breeder reserves the first right of refusal if cat is to be re-homed.

If Buyer fails to comply with any aspect of this agreement, Buyer forfeits any rights Buyer may otherwise have.

The Kitten must be paid for in full at least 2 weeks before bringing kitten home. Buyer will receive shot/worming records, and Blue Litter TICA or CFA Registration Paper for kitten upon veterinarian proof of spay/neuter.

Buyer is responsible for TICA/CFA registry and payment.
